Title I Nonpublic School Program 2024-2025 Final Report

Program Description

The 2024-2025 Title I Nonpublic School Program operated at 26 sites: All Saints Academy, Bishop Hartley, Bishop Ready, Brice Christian Academy, Clintonville Academy, Columbus Adventist Academy, Columbus Montessori, Columbus Torah Academy, Cypress Christian, Harvest Preparatory, Holy Spirit, immaculate Conception, Our Lady of Peace, Shepherd Christian, Sonshine Christian, St. Catharine, St. James the Less, St. Mary, St. Mary Magdalene, St. Josephine Bakhita, St. Paul Lutheran, Sunrise Academy, St. Timothy, Tooba Academy, Trinity Academy, and Worthington Adventists Academy. Students at twenty-three sites received reading services; nine sites provided mathematics services.

A total of 928 Pupils were served in Reading, and 274 pupils were served in Mathematics at the grades shown below.

For evaluation purposes, the program began on August 11, 2024 and continued through June 4, 2025. The maximum number of days a Pupil could be served varied from site to site, depending on the established school year calendar and the Title I funding available for the site.

READING PROGRAM

One desired outcome was established for the Title I Nonpublic School Reading Program for 2024-2025.

Desired Outcome

Of the Pupils who were enrolled for more than twenty-three weeks and attended the program at least 81% of the instructional period, seventy percent will increase their GE in Reading Comprehension on the STAR Assessment by one or more grade levels from Pre-Test to Post-Test.

Results

Title I Reading

A total of 928 Pupils in grades K through 10 were served in the Title I Nonpublic School Reading Program. 842 (91%) Pupils served, met the attendance criteria, and 822 (89%) had Pre-Test and Post-Test.

Parent Involvement

Parent involvement information was maintained by Program Teachers and Tutors. The Parents of the 928 Pupils served in the Reading Program made 1,033, an average of 1.11 contacts with Program Tutors, and 702 (76%) Pupils have School-Parent Compacts completed and on file with the Tutor.

MATHEMATICS PROGRAM

One desired outcome was established for the Title I Nonpublic School Mathematics Program for 2024-2025.

Desired Outcome

Of the Pupils who are enrolled for more than twenty-two weeks, and attended the program at least 40%, will increase their mathematics GE score on the STAR Assessment by at least one or more grade levels from Pre-test to Post-Test.

Results

Title | Math

A total of 274 Pupils in grades K through 8 were served in the Title I Nonpublic School Math Program. 262 (96%) Pupils served, met the attendance criteria, and 252 (92%) had Pre-Test and Post-Test.

Parent Involvement

Parent involvement information was maintained by Program Teachers and Tutors. The Parents of the 274 Pupils served in the Math Program made 267 an average of .97 contacts with Program Tutors, and 186 (68%) Pupils have School-Parent Compacts completed and on file with the Tutor.
