Acceptable Use Policy for Computer Resources

Overview

Calumet Christian School has made a substantial investment in our computer and network resources. In order to be good stewards of these resources we adopted the following guidelines.

Students have access to the computer and Internet for the following:

- School related assignments and assessments
- Using software/programs assigned by the teacher to supplement class curriculum
- Internet research
- School related PowerPoint assignments
- Google Classroom ®

Guidelines

- All computer use must be for specific educational purposes that have been assigned by a teacher
- Students are not allowed to send, receive or check e-mail
- Access to Social Media is prohibited
- Internet searches must be for specific projects assigned by a teacher
- Accessing games, gambling, pornography or non-school activity related sites are prohibited
- Changing computer settings and downloading software is prohibited
- Students will not share passwords and/or usernames. They will treat them as private property
- Students/parents must pay for damages that occur from the improper use of computer resources
- Failure to observe the above guidelines may/will result in temporary/permanent loss of computer privileges
- The Dwell Community Church network has a filter in place to block and monitor access to inappropriate sites. All attempts to access these sites are logged by the Information Services Department and reported to the building principal.
