COVID-19 items for School Supplies

FACE MASKS

- **These requirements and allowances are state mandated.**
- Required for **all staff and Elementary /Middle School students** for the 2020-2021 school year, until further notice.
- Recommended but *not required* for Preschool Students.
- Preschool staff will be wearing some combination of Personal Protective Equipment.

WATER BOTTLE

- Each student should have a water bottle that has a good seal.
- The water bottle should be large enough to last the day (not requiring a refill- but we will accommodate when necessary.
- The water bottle should be **metal or plastic. PLEASE NO GLASS.**
- Preschool Students will need to be able to **open and close** the bottle without assistance.

Calumet Christian School is requiring that face covering be worn during in-class times.

- The exception to this, will be during **outdoor time** when students can be **socially distant**. There will be a designated area where students can remove their masks outdoors, where they can be at least 6 feet from other students.
- Masks will not be worn during the students lunch break.
- Playground and soccer, free play areas, will be considered 'mask on – not socially distant' areas.
- We recommend that your student have **one mask** to be worn to school, and a **back-up mask** (in the event that an ear loop tears, the mask becomes sweaty or soiled, or the student misplaces the mask) for EACH day. This may mean having a modest supply of masks for your student- at home. Whether they are **washable/re-usable**, or **paper masks**.

All students will be issued a lanyard on the first day. These lanyards attach to the loops of the mask and will hang around the student's necks to prevent masks from being lost or mishandled.

In spelling out the quantity of face covering we think would be helpful, we need to also limit the types of MASKS that will be allowed.

We **cannot allow students** to have

- Gaiters
- Bandanas
- Valve masks.

We are asking that you provide

- Paper masks
- Or
- Double layered cloth masks

As stated in the Student Handbooks (pertaining to the dress code), these items should be free of inappropriate depiction in writing, or as images.
